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Wednesday 7 August 2024 NEW WALK	10:30am	4 miles	One of our longer walks with some inclines	Valehouse and Rhodeswood Reservoirs, Longendale	Going uphill past Christ Church Tintwistle SK13 1JR on the right on the main Woodhead Road (A628), the entrance to the United Utilities Longdendale Environmental Centre is signposted on the right another 200 metres or so further on (see directions)	From Stalybridge A6018 Mottram Road, up past Stalybridge Celtic to pass the Waggon & Horses pub on the right, then down through 'Deep Cutting' to the mini roundabout. Take the 2nd exit down and through the traffic lights onto Mottram Moor A57. From Gun Inn stay in left lane and go through traffic lights at the Gun Inn. The road is now the A628 [for Woodhead]. Continue through Hollingworth and then down the dip and up to go past Armfield Reservoir [on Left] into Tintwistle. Continue until road starts to climb. Go past Christ Church on the right and, another church on the left and after another 200 metres, just beyond the 40MPH sign, watch out for and turn into the layby looking signposted entrance to the Longdendale Environmental Centre on the RIGHT. CAREFUL! IT'S TUCKED AWAY Turn in and continue down, passing to the LEFT of the Centre building. Continue down until you reach the point where the road crosses between Valehouse and Bottoms Reservoirs. Cross along the 'dam road' and the Car Park is on your LEFT.
