Take the 2nd exit down and through the traffic lights onto Mottram Moor A57. From Gun Inn stay in left lane and go through traffic lights at the Gun Inn. The road is now the A628 [for Woodhead]. Continue through Hollingworth and then down the dip and up to go past Armfield Reservoir [on Left] into Tintwistle. Continue until road starts to climb. Go past Christ Church on the right and, another church on the left and after another 200 metres, just beyond the 40MPH sign, watch out for and turn into the layby looking signposted entrance to the Longdendale Environmental Centre on the RIGHT. CAREFUL! IT'S TUCKED AWAY Turn in and continue down, passing to the LEFT of the Centre building. Continue down until you reach the point where the road crosses between Valehouse and Bottoms Reservoirs. Cross along the 'dam road' and the Car Park is on your LEFT.
